

The years before a child enters school directly impact a child's ability to thrive in kindergarten and beyond. <u>School Readiness</u> means preparing all children for kindergarten by supporting birth-to-five programming by:

- Using high-quality curriculum and assessment strategies
- Encouraging teacher-child interactions
- Providing individualized professional development
- Creating programming that supports family engagement



Virginia Department of Education is responsible for child care licensing/regulation and the child care subsidy program. This shift is part of Virginia's broader effort to unify and strengthen the birth-to-five landscape in Virginia.

When these three components come together, children and families benefit which results in a benefit to the Commonwealth of Virginia.






